## **RESERVATIONS**

For dining reservations only, Princeton Club members must call Scarsdale Golf Club at 914-723-2840 (identifying themselves as a PC member). For tee times, PC members must contact Dan Daly, Golf Services Manager, (914) 725-6650 or email [ddaly@scarsdalegolfclub.org](mailto:ddaly@scarsdalegolfclub.org) to ensure availability prior to arrival.

## **DINING**

### **Dress Code**

Scarsdale Golf Club offers many dining concepts. The dress code varies accordingly. Please be certain to ask about the dress code when making your dining reservation. Gentlemen of all ages are required to wear collared shirts that must remain tucked in at all times.

### **Cell Phones**

Cell phones and electronic devices may not be used for voice calls in any of the dining areas. Quiet use of cell phones for texting, checking email, surfing the internet, photos etc. is permitted.

## **GOLF**

### **Golf Course Hours**

PC golfers will be accommodated based upon availability. Tee times may be made for Friday starting on Wednesday, Saturday on Thursday and Sunday times on Friday. The Head Golf Professional and Golf Services Manager have discretion at all times to modify these rules in order to achieve the most efficient use of our golf course.

### **Regular Season Times**

PC Members will be permitted to play during the following times:

<b>Tuesdays</b> Open at 12:00 noon	<b>Fridays</b> Open at 8:00am
<b>Wednesdays</b> Open at 12:00 noon	<b>Saturdays</b> Open at 8:00am
<b>Thursdays</b> Open at 8:00 am	<b>Sundays</b> Open at 8:00am

## **Guest Rules**

Upon arrival, PC Members must register at the Pro Shop by name and membership number.

No PC guest will be permitted to play unless the guest plays with a PC member.

PC members may play golf no more than two times per month with a cap of six rounds per calendar year. This is a cumulative limitation to PC members regardless of the number of SGC members who invite the PC member.

Caddies are required before 3:00 pm. PC members will only be permitted to use Scarsdale Golf Club's golf and dining facilities (No Pool, Tennis, Fitness, Paddle or Bowling).

## **Golf**

Green Fees: Weekdays (Tues. through Thurs.) \$125/ Weekends (Fri. through Sun.) \$150

Cart Fee: \$70 (for two)

Gratuities are only permissible for services in the Locker Room areas and Valet.

PC members may bring no more than three guests per day. On Saturdays and Sundays prior to 11:30 am, PC members may only bring one guest. After 11:30 am they may bring up to three guests.

## **Dress Code**

(Golf Course, Driving Range and Putting Greens)

Applies to adults and children, members and guests. Metal spikes are prohibited:

*Men* – Golf slacks or Bermuda length shorts which come to just above the knee. Turtleneck, mock turtleneck or collared shirts which must be tucked in at all times. Hats must be worn properly (not backwards).

*Women* – Golf slacks, Bermuda shorts, culottes and golf skirts. No tee shirts or tennis attire, short shorts, tank tops, denim or jeans of any kind are permitted on any of the golf facilities.

The changing of attire (including shoes) is restricted to the Locker Rooms.

## **Cell Phones & Electronic Devices**

Cell phones are not to be used on the golf course, putting green and practice range except for medical emergencies. GPS applications for cell phones are permitted to be used on the golf course. PC Members are responsible for informing their guests of this policy.

## **Pace of Play**

(Rules apply to play on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays)

For tee times between 8:00 am and 2:00 pm, a round of golf should be completed in 4 hours.

A round of golf of 4:10 hours, and no more than a 10 minute gap behind the group ahead will be tolerated and not deemed to be a violation warranting penalty.

A round of golf in excess of 4:10 hours and a 10 minute gap is a violation.

All rounds will be timed and violations will be communicated to the PC member.

Penalties for Pace of Play Violations:

First Violation: All players in the group will be issued a warning.

Second Violation: The PC member shall be prohibited from playing the course.

All golfers in the group have the responsibility to keep up with the group in front, not ahead of the group behind. Importantly, slow groups should permit faster groups to play through. To a large extent, the courtesy of the players must be relied upon to observe this rule, but the players entitled to play through have the responsibility to insist upon the right in order that the course may not be unnecessarily blocked. A course ranger may be employed to police the general speed of play and at the discretion of the Golf Committee warning letters may be issued for violations.

## **Caddies**

The use of caddies will be governed as follows: PC Members are encouraged to use a caddie at all times; however, a caddie is required until 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m., carts may go out without caddies at the discretion of the Golf Services Manager.

The Golf Services Manager will be responsible for the assignment of caddies to all groups or players.

During the times when a caddie is required with a golf cart, the Golf Services Manager will assign one or more caddies to a group as he deems desirable in view of the existing number of caddies available at the time.

## **Caddie Fees**

Caddies at Scarsdale Golf Club are considered independent contractors. As such, players utilizing caddies are encouraged to compensate their caddies based on the level of service rendered. The following guidelines have been established to provide a reasonable range based on a reasonable level of service.

Caddie fees: \$80-100 per golfer paid directly to the caddie in cash.

Forecaddie fees: \$40-\$50 per player.

## **Golf Carts and Cart Fees**

All operation of golf carts is restricted to persons 16 years of age and older with a valid driver's license.

There are no exceptions to this regulation. An adult must accompany children under the age of 16.

Golf cart fees shall be \$70 for 18 holes for two riders. For one rider the fee is one-half of the stated fee.

Use of golf carts, as the conditions on the course permit, will be governed by the following regulations:

Obey all directional and stop signs on the course. Do not go inside of directional arrows at greens, or within 20 feet of any green approach, tee or trap. On the 5th, 11th, 13th, and 15th holes, players must park on the cart path and walk to their ball. Use slow speed on all slopes to avoid damage to turf. Avoid all wet areas.

Riders must remain seated while the golf cart is in motion. Keep arms, legs and feet inside the cart while it is in motion. Drive slowly in turns and use brakes on slopes. Drive straight up and down slopes to prevent potentially flipping the cart. Set parking brake before leaving the cart. The operator should keep speeds low enough to avoid hazards, falling out, or collision. Operate the cart only from the driver's seat.

Excessive water on the course or extreme grass wilting conditions will, from time to time, cause the restriction of golf cart use. Persons eligible to use carts during these restricted use periods are only those players who never walk under any conditions, or players with a current medical reason. During restricted use periods, golf carts may be driven only in the rough, and the cart user must park in the rough and walk out to the ball.

When carts are operated without caddies, players must take extraordinary measures to ensure against hitting blind shots into other players. The most dangerous situations will arise on the back nine, and players are urged to take extra precautions.

#### **Golf Course Care**

Replace divots, rake sand traps, repair ball marks. Do not walk through bunkers. Please place all litter including bottles, cans and paper in the receptacles provided.
